The Elementary playground is in need of equipment. There are items that can be purchased from the Campbell's Soup catalog. The Elementary Student Council has over 40,000 points and can use these to purchase items. Other items that are being considered are: buckets, shovels, plastic spoons, garden trowels and a standing mesh/net bag to hold these items. More information will be given at the next meeting.

n. Scholarships

The Booster Club currently offers a \$100 scholarship for the Valedictorian as well as a \$100 scholarship for the Salutatorian. There was discussion on offering another scholarship for School Spirit. More will be discussed at the next meeting (application form, terms, etc.).

Requests approved via email:

A motion was made and approved in the amount of \$400 for the following request. A request came from Matt Amendt who requested for science class supplies. The bulk of it is for his Forensics class, which is new this year. He is hoping to offer it all year, but right now it is only a semester class. Forensics could really use Crime lab kits, which are lab supplies for working with "evidence" such as hair analysis, blood splatters, fingerprints, etc. These kits can be reused, although will require some of the components to be replenished every year. He also needs some posters for other classes, such as rock identification for Earth Science and a periodic chart for chemistry. The total of his supplies is around \$600, mostly for Forensics.

A motion was made by Wendy Rohleder and seconded by Shelly Gould to reimburse Adele Waits for purchasing items for goodies bags for the girls going to the volleyball regional's on Friday, October 31, 2008.
