- 7. Park and Recreation Mrs. Ardrey/Mr. Gresham The potential of having concessions at the Babe Ruth games was discussed.
- 8. Athletic Director Principal/Athletic Director Graves reported:
 - Coaching recommendations A couple of coaching additions, one a high school asst. coach and the other a volunteer junior high coach.
 - Legislative Council Update Legislative Council met last month. The vote failed regarding repealing the six classifications in basketball which means Elbert High School will remain 2A; the transfer rule will not go back to the 50% rule (a transfer student would play junior varsity for 50% of the games and then could play 50% varsity) it will stay as it is also.
 - Summer Schedules Coach Graves has completed HS and MS schedules for Football, Volleyball, Basketball and Matchwits. Baseball is in progress. Track will be completed in late fall. Also over the summer coaches will be signed up on the CHSAA online platform and all coaches will be setup with CHSCA for the various clinics.

9. Administration –

- End of Year Activities End of year activities all took place and were great. The Spring Concert was cancelled due to Mr. Goodger having to go back to Wisconsin due to a parent passing.
- Secondary Schedule A student will be attending next month's meeting, it is recommendation by staff that he may be retained. Several Middle School Students are struggling in the 7th grade there are 10-15 students who will take a study skills class.
- Summer School There will be Summer School this summer; 2 weeks in June, week of the 14th and 21st and two weeks in July, week of the 11th and 18th.
- NWEA Scores/Evaluations –Students NWEA scores showed growth on the end of year NWEA tests given so all teachers made the growth requirement on their teacher evaluation.
- School Lunch prices State has a tool to help determine lunch prices but at this time not sure that we will have to adjust our lunch pricing.
- Impact Fees Elbert County has added to the Building Permitting Process a form that all new residential homes will pay volunteer building contribution. It will be up to the schools to come up with a volunteer contribution. Bennett Schools did a study that included Elbert County and so we are able to use their data and pricing spreadsheet.
- Movie Filming An episode of Fragment, a television series, has been using the school for some of their episode and several

- community members, staff and students have been extras in scenes.
- CoAction Grant Elbert, Kiowa and Elizabeth have joined again in trying get another federal grant for HVAC ventilation in the Woodshop, CTE Salaries, pole barn for woodshop, etc. We should know in a week or two if it is awarded.
- FAMLI consensus of Administration and Board is to opt out of this State plan. We will look at this again and take action in July.
